Crime Victims' Compensation

The Crime Victims' Compensation Program is administered by the Office of the Attorney General providing financial assistance to eligible victims of crime for crime-related costs (Medical care, mental health care, funeral expenses, loss of support/earnings, relocation, travel expenses, crime scene clean-up, child & dependent care, replacement of seized property). Crime Victims' Compensation covers crime-related costs not paid by other sources.
